Welcome teachers to the first ART meeting of LIC 9 Explain that in this LIC, they will be using the ART meetings to reflect on what they have recently learned in their in-service trainings and plan for its implementation Introduce the theme of this LIC – Building a Stronger Community – and the importance of supporting each other in their own professional growth by observing each other and giving developmental feedback
	 Review the aims for this ART meeting and display them: Reflecting on what we have learnt recently through in-service training and identifying areas of support required Creating an implementation plan for what we have learnt Deciding on peer observation dates and processes

	with each other and give feedback in writing, for example).

	 Ask teachers to share their responses on chat
	 Give all teachers a few minutes to read the responses on chat
