Minutes of the meeting of Annual PAC- 2024-25 of SCERT

A meeting of the Annual Programme Advisory Committee (PAC) of SCERT was held on 12th June 2024 at 11:00 am in the Conference Hall of SCERT, chaired by Shri Ashok Kumar, Secretary of Education, GNCTD. The purpose of the meeting was to review the progress of projects approved in the Annual PAC and Mid Term PAC for FY 2023-24 and to consider and approve new projects for SCERT for the year 2024-25. - 2. At the outset Dr. Rita Sharma, Director, SCERT, welcomed the Chairperson and other distinguished members of the PAC. She highlighted the achievements of the SCERT and briefed the members about the activities conducted by SCERT during the year 23-24. She briefed the committee about the achievements and accolades from the previous year, which include:
 - Successful organization of two national level conferences i.e 2-days national conference on Education, focused on the theme Institutionalising Change: NEP 2020 and the Vision of New Classroom & one day conference on the Power of Entrepreneur Education Developing Youth Mindset for Innovation & Economic Growth.
 - Google Training for Heads of Schools (HOS) on the utilization of ICT tools and digital leadership.
 - Premier Institution-Based Trainings for different stakeholders in collaborations with esteemed institutions such as Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs), Indian Institute of Technology (IITs), Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE), English & Foreign Language University (EFLU), and Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS).
 - Development of Functional curriculum is a tailor made curriculum for age group 4 to 18 years, for developing an array of skills to promote functional academics including reading & writing, time management, money handling, community orientation, independent living etc., with severe & profound intellectual disabilities.



4. Approval/ Suggestions of the PAC:

The committee directed that the proposed budget should align with the approved outlay of Rs. 62 crore for the fiscal year 2024-25, as designated by the GNCTD. Activities should be prioritized based on need and requirements, while adhering to the approved budget ceiling of Rs. 62 Crores for the year 2024-25. If there is a need for additional budget allocation for academic activities, it should be proposed during the supplementary stage for additional grants.

The committee made the following suggestions:

- 1. Minimize print publications and focus on e-copies wherever possible. Materials/textbooks for students should be printed in hard copies for dissemination.
- 2. For financial year 24-25 if there are unused or unspent funds in any head, reappropriation or reallocation of the approved funds can be done for other head, based on priority assessment.
- 3. Collaborate and increase training with pioneer institutions like IIMs, IITs, EFLU and TISS to offer experiences and interaction with different faculties. Also to organize visits to schools with different management & geographical diversities
- 4. Appreciated the inclusion of art/theatre themes in the trainings
- 5. The incorporation of TESOL training for English teachers of DoE was appreciated, and it was suggested to extend this training to DIET D.ELEd trainces.
- 6. Emphasized that trainings should be conducted on Competency based Assessment.
- 7. Use TTMS for training-related data records.
- 8. Appreciated the Vidyanjali initiatives by SCERT as it promotes community participation and suggested organizing the Vidyanjali Samman Programme on quarterly basis.
- 9. Appreciated the functional curriculum developed for 4-18 age groups of children with disabilities with special emphasis on severe & profound intellectual disabilities, which is under pilot testing in 15 govt. schools of DoE GNCTD.

Shri Ashok Kumar, Secretary and Chairperson of the committee, directed that new proposals and programs must be completed in the time bound manner and the budget is utilized effectively to achieve the desired outcomes during the year FY 2024-25.
