#### **CIRCULAR**

In pursuance of letter No.UD-L05/5/2025/SBM-UD/E-247945/8735 dated 25.07.2025 of Department of Urban Development, GNCT of Delhi, and as per decision of Govt of NCT of Delhi, a Swachhata Drive is to taken up in Delhi during August, 2025 beginning w.e.f 1st August, 2025.

SCERT, Delhi is going to undertake the activities in alignment with the objectives of Swachh Bharat Mission and the vision of "Swachhata Drive in Delhi" for a healthier, eco-conscious campuses during August 2025.

The Director, SCERT directs all District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs) and affiliated Teacher Education Institutions to implement the enclosed 30-Day Sanitation & Clean Campus Plan during August 2025. The Action Plan attached at **Annexure** "C" will ensure that each campus will:

- engage students and staff in Shramdan (voluntary cleaning drives) at designated 'Each
  One Clean One' spots (1 inside campus + 1 outside campus). The list of identified spots and
  before & after photos, videos are to be taken and upload at link given below
- Promote awareness about sanitation, waste segregation, hygiene, and eco-Friendly practices through workshops, plays, and creative campaigns.
- Involve local community/ RWAs in collaborative cleanliness activities.
- Develop sustainable habits like composting, green transport, and reduction of single-use plastic.
- Form a student-led Clean Campus Committee for ongoing efforts beyond the campaign.

- 2. hold weekly online reflection meetings (every Saturday) for reviewing activities and planning the upcoming week.

- Best of Waste- Institute Level Competition- Best I, II, III award SCERT level selection, date and time will be decided later on.
