With reference to Sanction order 227 dated 9th August 2023, activities under Video Development of Nukkad Natak for the awareness of Vidyanjali Programme are being organized in the month of August 2023. These activities will be organized by SCERT & DIETs. The details of the activities are as follows—

Activity 1: One Day Workshop on orientation of Vidyanjali Nukkad Natak for D.El.Ed & B.Ed. trainees at SCERT.

Date: 16 Aug 2023

Time: 10 am – 5 pm

Venue: Room no 202, Second floor, Training Wing, SCERT

Procedure: All DIETs and B.Ed Division SCERT will send 10 trainees (Nukkad Natak Participants) to attend the one day workshop on orientation of Vidyanjali Nukkad Natak at SCERT. Two faculty from each DIET along with students may attend the programme. The students will be oriented about Vidyanjali Prog. Nukkad Natak and development of reels for Vidyanjali Promotion. The students will come in proper uniform and shall carry their identity cards. In case of new admissions, the DIETs may issue provisional identity cards.

Activity 2: 5 Days Workshop for Nukkad Natak Competition for D.El.Ed./ B.Ed Trainees.

Date: 17,18,21,22,23 August 2023

Time: Full day

Venue: Respective DIETs and B.Ed. Division SCERT

Procedure: All DIETs and B.Ed Division SCERT will conduct 5 days workshop for the preparation of Nukkad Natak Competition. One Resource person for a day may be invited for the workshop. Dress, Make-up and Conveyance allowance for Nukkad Natak competition from DIET to venue for the team is also provided in the sanction. Maximum 15 participants along with 2 persons (1 may be faculty & 1 may be MTS or 2 faculty in case of no requirement of MTS) are invited for the competition on 29 August 2023 at Indian Islamic Centre.

Activity 3: Vidyanjali Orientation Cum-Mela

Date: 25 August 2023

Time: 10 am – 2 pm

Venue: Respective DIETs and B.Ed. Division SCERT

Procedure: Maximum 200 people from community (Hospitals / Banks / Educational Institutes/ Public Schools / Alumni / Parents / SMC members / RWA members / NGOs / Organizations/ College Students / Lawyers / Embassies / Trust members of Temple, Gurudwara etc.) may be invited in the Vidyanjali Orientation Cum Mela. The purpose of this programme is to bring community closer to schools by connecting them with Vidyanjali as a volunteer. Refreshments, tea and a kit bag with Vidyanjali awareness material may be provided as per the sanction to participants.

Activity 4: Video Development of Nukkad Natak for the awareness of Vidyanjali Programme in the form of competition.

Date: 29st August 2023

Time: 10am – 5pm

Venue- Indian Islamic Centre

Procedure: A competition on Vidyanjali Nukkad Natak will be organized by State Team Vidyanjali SCERT Delhi for the D.El.Ed and B.Ed. trainees on 29th August at Indian Islamic Centre.

Theme: Vidyanjali Ko Jaano...

The Guidelines for the Vidyanjali Nukkad Natak Competition are as follows –

The primary goal of a nukkad natak is to create awareness and inspire positive change. The nukkad natak presentation from all teams will be recorded and the videos will be used for Vidyanjali promotion on Social Media.

Team Registration – The detailed list of maximum 15 participants along with 2 persons (1 may be faculty & 1 may be MTS or 2 faculty in case of no requirement of MTS) is to be shared along with their script and a short video clip or can send a link (the clip must be of 5-8 minutes which is to be shared through Google drive link) of video they have performed already at vidyanjaliscertdelhi@gmail.com on or before 24th August 2023. Please ensure to mention the Institution and team name with the video.

Judgement Criteria - The Judgement Criteria will be based on:

1. Quality of content (10 marks)
2. Voice Pitching and Action (10 marks)
3. Crowd Interaction and Audience Response (10 marks)
4. Social message (How connecting with Vidyanjali is beneficial for both school & volunteer) (10 marks)

Time limit: Maximum 15 minutes (10+5) including set up time [8 min: warning bell, 10min: final bell]. Team exceeding the final bell will attract negative markings. (up to 1min – 1 mark, 2min – 2 marks and so on)

- Use of fire (candle, diyas, etc.) and liquid item is strictly prohibited. Also, using any hazardous props/elements is forbidden.
- Teams must bring their props, costume, dressing and all other requirements. Teams need to inform the stage committee about the props beforehand.
- Teams must be ready with everything in time as per instruction of organizer.

The DIETs and B.Ed Division SCERT are requested to instruct the students to maintain discipline in the programme as Video Development of Nukkad Natak is the main aim of this programme. The students shall carry their identity cards. In case of new admissions, the DIETs may issue provisional identity cards.
