## Sub: Grant of permission for acquiring higher qualification through Distance Mode.

Director SCERT, is pleased to grant permission to all the academic staff of SCERT to pursue higher education through distance mode on the terms & conditions laid down by SCERT as under: -

1. The intimation of pursuing higher education shall be submitted to Admn. Branch, SCERT before the last date of application.

2. The work of SCERT/DIET shall always have priority over and above anything.

3. The permission will be further subject to the conditions laid down by the Council from time to time.

4. The permission does not ipso-facto confer any right for continued posting in this Council for duration of the course.

5. The pursuit of studies should be without detriment to efficient discharge of official duties.

6. The grant of permission will not entitle the officer to leave office at his/her discretion. On occasions requiring his/her presence in office beyond office hours, he/she will stay in office till the time required without any objection and will forego his/her classes if warranted in public interest.

7. The administration will accept no responsibility for his/her failure to complete the percentage of compulsory attendance prescribed for the course, if any, on this account.

8. The permission will not entitle his/her to claim leave for the preparation of examination. Leave, if any, required for appearing in the examination will be sanctioned subject to the title and exigencies of work and subject to the conditions that SCERT will not provide Study Leave for the same.

However, in case of regular course, applicants are required to submit application form in prescribed proforma for obtaining permission for acquiring higher /additional qualification. The application should be submitted to Administration Branch seven days before the last date and in case permission is not granted, the qualification acquired will not be accepted.
