CIRCULAR

Sub:- “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign to celebrate “Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava”.

This is in reference to DoE's letter No.F.No.1(1062)/CTB/Har Ghar Tiranga/2022/1048 dated 30.07.2022 (**Annexure-“A”**) regarding “Har Ghar Tiranga” Action Points in addition to circular No.F.42/DE/PE & NI/2022-23/714-62 dated 27.07.2022 (**Annexure-“B”**).

Under the “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign the Tricolor is proposed to be hoisted atop more than 20 Crore houses as well as Govt. and Private Institutions / Establishments across the country from 13th to 15th August, 2022 through public participation.

Accordingly all Principal DIETs are directed to take the following action under “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign to celebrate 75th year of Independence “Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava” in SCERT and all DIETs.

1. All DIETs will hoist Tricolor atop their building from 13th to 15th August, 2022.
2. For popularizing the “Har Ghar Tiranga” initiative and for ensuring maximum public participation to make a programme grand success, all DIETs will launch a special information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign for public sensitization and awareness of students, parents and staff with immediate effect.
3. Special assembly and awareness programme may be conducted in every DIET to motivate for maximum participation by the students, parents and staff members. Members may also be involved to motivate the parents and people living in the vicinity.
4. Social media may be used for popularizing the “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign and to encourage the students, parents and staff members to upload a selfie with a flag on the portal “<https://harghartiranga.com>”.
5. For the success of the campaign and timely availability of Tricolor, the requirement of flags and their procurement may be planned well in time. The students, parents and staff may be encouraged to purchase the flags.
6. SCERT and all DIETs may procure the flags either through the registered vendors on the GeM portal or through Self Help Groups (SHGs)/Other Manufacturers /Suppliers.
7. The contingency fund may be utilized to procure the Tricolor.
8. “Prabhat Pheries” (observing COVID-19 appropriate behaviour) may be organised by the students from 11th August, 2022 to 14th August, 2022 to create awareness among people regarding “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign and to hoist Tricolor atop of their houses/buildings in the neighbourhood area.

9. The flag code of India has been amended vide order dated 20th July, 2022 which allows that "Where the flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, It may be flown day and night" Salient features of the flag code of India 2002 are attached at Annexure-"C". It may be ensured that all actions may be taken as per the Flag Code.
10. All Principals will monitor the "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign on daily basis and encourage students and staff to ensure maximum participation from their respective DIETs.
