Subject: Capacity Building Program for Middle stage for NIPUN Sankalp initiatives for classes 6th to 8th .

NIPUN Sankalp is a comprehensive initiative launched by the Directorate of Education (DoE) and State Council of Education Research and Training (SCERT), Delhi to ensure that all children from Classes 1 to 8 acquire Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) competencies. In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, this initiative aims to bridge existing learning gaps and to strengthen the foundational stage, with particular focus on Classes 1 to 8.

The initiative follows a diversified approach focusing on targeted interventions, teacher capacity building, community engagement, and continuous monitoring to ensure sustainable FLN outcomes.

To ensure effective implementation, a Two-Day Capacity Building Programme for Master Trainers teaching Classes 6th to 8th has been conducted on 9 July to 10 July 2026.

Capacity Building Program of NIPUN Sankalp for the teachers teaching in classes 6 to 8 (DoE/DCB/NDMC) is to be conducted district wise through DIETs for effective implementations. The CBP Will Focus on Conduction of Baseline Assessment and Pedagogical practices with respect to NIPUN Sankalp. The details of the Capacity Building Programme is as under:

Duration: 2-days

Dates: 05 August 2026 to 12 August 2026 (Teachers will attend as per the communication from concerned DIET)

Participants: 3 teachers from each school (TGT English, TGT Hindi, TGT Maths) teaching in classes 6-8.

All Heads of Schools are to:

- i) Depute teachers as per the above-mentioned criteria for attending the programme as communicated by the Concerned DIETs.. Attendance of nominated teachers on both days of Capacity Building Program is mandatory.

ii) Depute the Master Trainers for CBP as per the Schedule given by DIETs.
