All of you are requested to follow the below mentioned steps (**Please note the programme cannot be accessed and enrolled if the user has not logged in**). If you already have the DIKSHA App on your phone, please ensure that you update the DIKSHA App before you enrol for the programme.

How to Enrol in the DIKSHA Course

For Mobile Users (Android & iOS)

To enrol and complete the course on a mobile device, you **must download two apps**:

- The standard **DIKSHA** app.
- The specialized **DIKSHA Courses** app (available via the Google Play Store).

1. **Install & Update:** Install the **DIKSHA** app. If you already have it, make sure it is updated to the latest version.
2. **Get the Course App:** install/open the **DIKSHA Courses** app.
3. **Log In:** Tap "**Login with DIKSHA**" on **DIKSHA Course App**. Sign in using your registered mobile number/email and password, or your Google account.
4. **Complete Profile:**
 - ✓ If your profile is already 100% complete, you will go straight to the course.
 - ✓ If incomplete, fill in your details (Role, Board, Medium, Class) and save.
5. **Join the Course:** Scan the QR code from the circular or click the course link. Once redirected to the course page, tap "**Join Course**" to enrol.

For Desktop / Laptop Users

1. **Access the Portal:** Click the course link provided in your circular
2. **Log In:** Click "**Login with DIKSHA**" and sign in using your credentials or Google account.
3. **Complete Profile:** If prompted, update your profile details (Role, Board, Medium, and Class) to 100% completion.
4. **Join the Course:** You will be automatically redirected to the course page. Click the "**Join Course**" button to begin.

Note: Certificates will be issued for completing this course and after qualifying the minimum score, i.e., 60%.
Certificate will be issued on the name which reflects on the user profile while taking the course.

The participants are advised to enrol and complete the programme, as per their convenience by the respective completion date of the programme without disturbing their school/Institute routine work & will do the programme at their own pace and at any place.
