CIRCULAR

Sub.: Veer Gatha Project Edition II -reg.

With reference to Ministry of Education D.O.No F.1-81/2022-Sch.3 dated 13th September 2022, in order to disseminate the acts of bravery and the life stories of these brave hearts among the students and instil among them a spirit of civic consciousness, it has been proposed by the Ministry of Defence (MoD) that school students may be motivated to do projects/activities based on gallantry award winners. Accordingly, the first edition of Project Veer Gatha was organized from Aug 2021 to Jan 2022, for schools affiliated to CBSE and state boards. In pursuance of the Veer Gatha the students undertook different projects on these gallantry award winners and the best projects were awarded nationally by MoD and Ministry of Education (MoE) on 12th August, 2022.

The MoD in coordination with MoE has now decided to launch Project Veer Gatha Edition – 2 which is proposed to be culminated with the prize distribution ceremony in January, 2023. Interdisciplinary and art-integrated activities like poem/essay/story/paragraph/painting/ drawing, videos, may be considered as project activities for the students

The draft modalities for the conduct of Project Veer Gatha Edition 2 are as follows: -

1. This project may be called Project VEERGATHA 2.0.
2. The Ministry of Defence, through field formations of Army/Navy/AirForce, will organize virtual/face-to-face awareness programs/sessions of one hour duration for schools across the country. During these interactive sessions, presentations will be made by the personnel of the armed forces on operation, battles resulting in conferment of awards. The service personnel will answer queries of students. Where possible short videos/PPTs/ documentaries/brochures and other resource material will be shared with students.
3. Interdisciplinary and art-integrated activities like poem, essay, story, painting/drawing, videos may be considered as project activities for the students.
4. Schools will need to register all participating students at the Gallantry Awards Portal of the MoD (<https://www.gallantryawards.gov.in>). A Unique ID will be given to all registered students. If a student's entry is selected at the school level, the Unique ID of that student will also be filled at the time of submission of entry at the CBSE/MyGov portal. Further, all unique IDs will be sent to MoD.

विषय: वीर गाथा परियोजना संस्करण II -regl

शिक्षा मंत्रालय के डी.ओ.सं.एफ.1-81/2022-एसएच.3 दिनांक 13 सितंबर 2022 के संदर्भ में, छात्रों के बीच बहादुरी के कार्यों और इन बहादुर दिलों की जीवन कहानियों को प्रसारित करने और उनमें नागरिक चेतना की भावना पैदा करने के लिए, रक्षा मंत्रालय (MoD) द्वारा यह प्रस्तावित किया गया है कि स्कूली छात्रों को वीरता पुरस्कार विजेताओं के आधार पर परियोजनाओं / गतिविधियों को करने के लिए प्रेरित किया जा सकता है। तदनुसार, सीबीएसई और राज्य बोर्डों से संबद्ध स्कूलों के लिए प्रोजेक्ट वीर गाथा का पहला संस्करण अगस्त 2021 से जनवरी 2022 तक आयोजित किया गया था। वीर गाथा के अनुसरण में छात्रों ने इन वीरता पुरस्कार विजेताओं पर विभिन्न परियोजनाएं शुरू कीं और 12 अगस्त, 2022 को रक्षा मंत्रालय और शिक्षा मंत्रालय (एमओई) द्वारा सर्वश्रेष्ठ परियोजनाओं को राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर सम्मानित किया गया।

MoD ने MoE के समन्वय से अब प्रोजेक्ट वीर गाथा संस्करण - 2 लॉन्च करने का निर्णय लिया है, जिसे जनवरी, 2023 में पुरस्कार वितरण समारोह के साथ समाप्त करने का प्रस्ताव है। अंतःविषय और कला-एकीकृत गतिविधियाँ जैसे कविता / निबंध / कहानी / अनुच्छेद / पेंटिंग / ड्राइंग, वीडियो, छात्रों के लिए परियोजना गतिविधियों के रूप में माना जा सकता है।

प्रोजेक्ट वीर गाथा संस्करण 2 के संचालन के लिए प्रारूप इस प्रकार है: -

1. इस परियोजना को परियोजना वीरगाथा 2.0 कहा जा सकता है।
2. रक्षा मंत्रालय, सेना/नौसेना/वायु सेना के क्षेत्रीय गठन के माध्यम से, देश भर के स्कूलों के लिए एक घंटे की अवधि के आभासी/आमने-सामने जागरूकता कार्यक्रम/सत्रों का आयोजन करेगा। इन संवादात्मक सत्रों के दौरान, सशस्त्र बलों के कर्मियों द्वारा ऑपरेशन, लड़ाई के परिणामस्वरूप पुरस्कार प्रदान किए जाने पर प्रस्तुतिकरण दिया जाएगा। सेवा कर्मी छात्रों के सवाल का जवाब देंगे। जहां संभव हो लघु वीडियो/पीपीटी/वृत्तचित्र/विवरणिका और अन्य संसाधन सामग्री छात्रों के साथ साझा की जाएगी।

5. As part of this project, the students can frame different projects such as poem / paragraph / story / drawing / video on gallantry award winners. The best project will be rewarded nationally by MoD on the forthcoming Republic Day. The submission by the students can be made in any of the 22 Scheduled languages and English.

CONCEPT NOTE

PROJECT VEER GATHA EDITION -2

Gallantry Awards have been instituted by the Government of India to honour the acts of bravery and sacrifice of the officers/personnel of the Armed Forces, other lawfully constituted Forces and civilians. These gallantry awards are announced twice in a year - first on the occasion of the Republic Day and then on the occasion of the Independence Day.

In order to disseminate the acts of bravery and the life stories of these brave hearts among the students and instill among them a spirit of civic consciousness, the Ministry of Defence (MoD) had proposed that school students may be motivated to do projects/activities based on gallantry award winners. Accordingly, the first edition of Project Veer Gatha was organized from Aug 2021 to Jan 2022, for schools affiliated to CBSE and State Boards. In pursuance of the Veergatha the students undertook different projects on these gallantry award winners and the best project was awarded nationally by MoD and Ministry of Education (MoE) on 12 Aug 2022.

The success of the project may be gauged from the fact that over 8 lakh students participated in various activities conducted in the first edition and pledged to become model citizens, following in the footsteps of their role-models, the gallantry award winners.

The MoD in coordination with MoE has now decided to launch Project Veergatha Edition-2 which is proposed to be culminated with the prize distribution ceremony in January 2023. The draft modalities for the conduct of Project Veergatha Edition 2 are as follows: -

1. This project may be called **Project VEERGATHA 2.0**.
2. The Ministry of Defence, through field formations of Army/Navy/Air Force, will organize virtual/face-to-face awareness programs/sessions of one hour duration for schools across the country. During these interactive sessions, presentations will be made by the personnel of the armed forces on operation, battles resulting in conferment of awards. The service personnel will answer queries of students. Where possible short videos/PPTs/ documentaries/brochures and other resource material will be shared with students.
3. Interdisciplinary and art-integrated activities like poem, essay, story, painting/drawing, videos may be considered as project activities for the students.
4. Schools will need to register all participating students at the Gallantry Awards Portal of the MoD (<https://www.gallantryawards.gov.in>). A Unique ID will be given to all registered students. If a student's entry is selected at the school level, the Unique

ID of that student will also be filled at the time of submission of entry at the CBSE/MyGov portal. Further, all unique IDs will be sent to MoD.

A Unique ID will be generated to all registered students which will be mandatory for participation in the event. No entry shall be evaluated at the school level unless the same is accompanied by the unique ID. Registration on GAP is mandatory for participation. If a student's entry is selected at the school level, the Unique ID of that student will be mandatorily filled at the time of submission of entry at the CBSE/MyGov portal. Further, all unique IDs will be sent to MoD. Nodal officers from the respective schools will be responsible to get the entries of the student uploaded on CBSE platform or MyGov in case of SCERTs to ensure genuine entries in the competition. BISAG-N will make necessary arrangements for generating the unique ID. The CBSE and SCERTs will ensure to make the project a family affair wherein the students and their family members will together understand this learning activity. The circular issued by the CBSE and all States/ UTs will encourage the students and their family members to visit the GAP and register themselves on the portal.

11. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: -

The CBSE / Respective State Boards/SCERTs/NCERT will bear the respective expenditure, if any, incurred during the actual conduct of the project at the school level and evaluation.

MoD will bear the expenses of the move of the prize winners along with one escort for each prize winner to Delhi via Economy Class Air Fare / 2 AC Rail Fare to attend the felicitation event at Delhi. The MoD will also bear the expense of the prize money to be given to the winners. Organizing the arrangements for stay and local transport for the winners along with one escort for each winner and incurring expenditure thereon for attending the felicitation event within Delhi as per program will be the responsibility of CBSE/Respective State Boards.

12. SOCIAL-MEDIA CAMPAIGN: -

The MoE and CBSE will be requested to instruct the schools to provide photographs / audio-visual clips and writeups about the various activities being conducted as part of the project. The USI will publicize the activities being undertaken by the schools on the various social media handles and accounts associated with the Gallantry Awards Portal (GAP) and similar action by CBSE and other SCERTs to publicize it on their respective platforms.

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The schools will be instructed to record the interaction of the students with the gallantry awardees, which will be uploaded on the YouTube channel associated with the GAP. The recordings can be viewed on GAP. The access of the recording will be controlled, based on registration on the portal.
