PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Abstract should be written in 150-250 words, 12pt. font size and Times New Roman Font with 1.15 line spacing with 4 to 5 keywords.
- The research papers must be written within the word limit of 2000-3000 words, 12pt. font size and Times New Roman Font with 1.15 line spacing.
- The first page of the paper must incorporate the title of the paper, name of the authors, affiliation and email address.
- Tables, illustrations, charts and figures should be serially numbered and duly acknowledged.
- All the references must be in APA, 7th edition including in-text citation.
- Only original and unpublished paper will be considered. It should be plagiarism free and not AI generated.
- Authors will present their papers at the conference. The selected papers will be published in conference proceeding having ISBN number.
